Two Fellowships are available from the Faculty of Science, the TransCanada Pipelines Graduate Fellowship in Science (\$6,450 for a single fellowship) and the Faculty of Science Graduate Fellowship — Cangene Fellowship (\$17,000, possibly split among more than one recipient). The TransCanada Pipelines Graduate Fellowship is open to any full-time graduate student in the Faculty of Science with high standing (minimum GPA 3.5), and the Cangene Fellowship is open to a full-time graduate student in the first two years of a MSc degree or first three years of a PhD degree, with excellent standing and demonstrated exceptional research ability. Please submit one application (Biological Sciences Awards Form) for both scholarships. The Department of Biological Sciences Scholarships and Awards committee will choose the best candidate among the applicants and submit that student's name to the Faculty of Science for adjudication of the awards. Applications, *including reference letters*, must be submitted by no later than **4pm Wednesday September 1**st.

The remaining awards, all of which are departmental and will be adjudicated within the Department, can be applied for using the same application form, indicating which awards are being applied for. If you are not applying for the TransCanada Pipelines or Cangene awards cited above, the application submission deadline is **4 pm Friday September 10**th. Letters of reference must be submitted no later than Sept. 15th. Please indicate the awards for which you are applying on the form. Please read the descriptions of each award (Biological Sciences web site - Graduate Students – Awards) before applying to be sure you are eligible. The Roger Evans Memorial Scholarship is a travel award, and if you apply for it, you must include the conference where you propose to present your work. This can be added at the end of the research proposal.
