

Biological Sciences Safety Training: quiz(zes) and a checklist must be completed before conducting any research activities or entering any labs

1. Lab personnel including principal investigator (PI) and support staff

When registering, use **your UofM email address** (if you do not have one, email scisafe@umanitoba.ca to request a sponsored WHMIS account).

Betty Lerner will send an email with the instructions to complete the quiz(zes).

- a. **Workplace safety quiz (general safety information required for all lab personnel/Pis)**
- b. **Lab safety and WHMIS quiz (if working with controlled products)**
- c. **Site-specific training (risk assessment) to be completed with supervisor (checklist)**

Any new lab personnel including PIs are required to complete the site-specific training (checklist) with the supervisor or Betty Lerner (for new PIs).

Betty Lerner will provide the appropriate checklist once the quiz(es) has/have been completed. You can also request a specific Safety Checklist from scisafe@umanitoba.ca

To complete the safety training the checklist must be kept by the trainee and an electronic copy sent to both the supervisor and scisafe@umanitoba.ca

- d. **Biosafety Training (as required) through EHS:**

If your supervisor holds a biosafety permit, in order to participate in the lab activities, you must complete the “**Biological Safety Training**” course on UMLearn (Code BSP_122021)
